

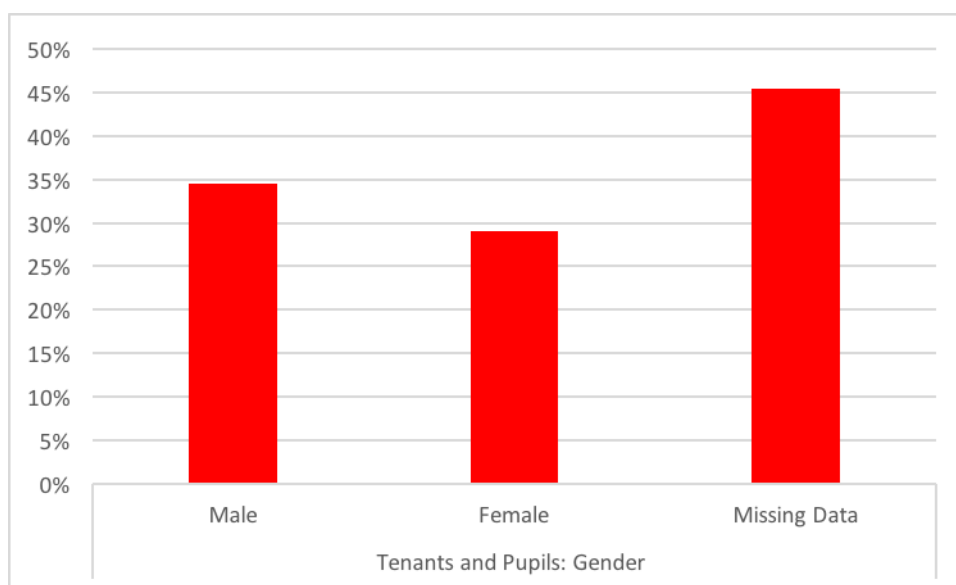


SUMMARY OF DIVERSITY DATA

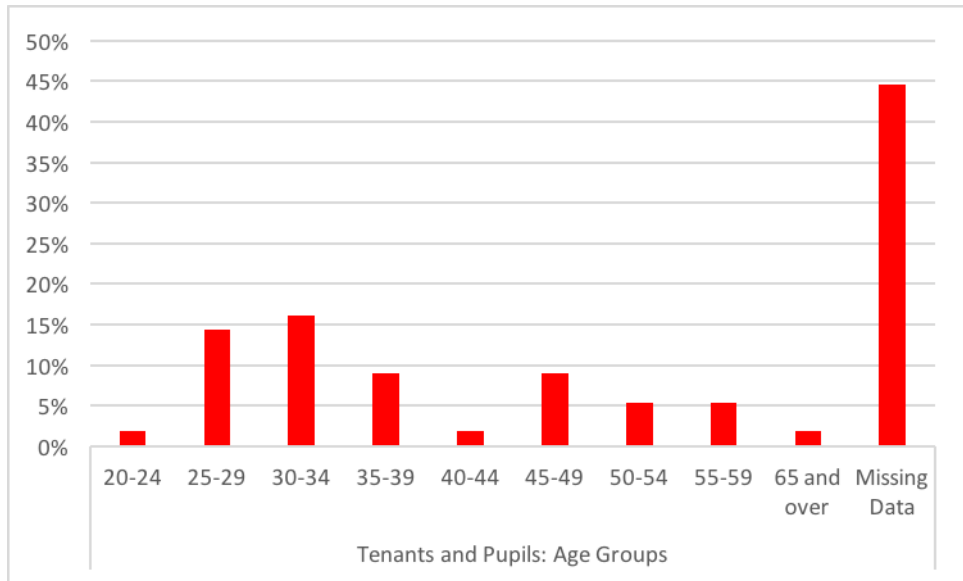

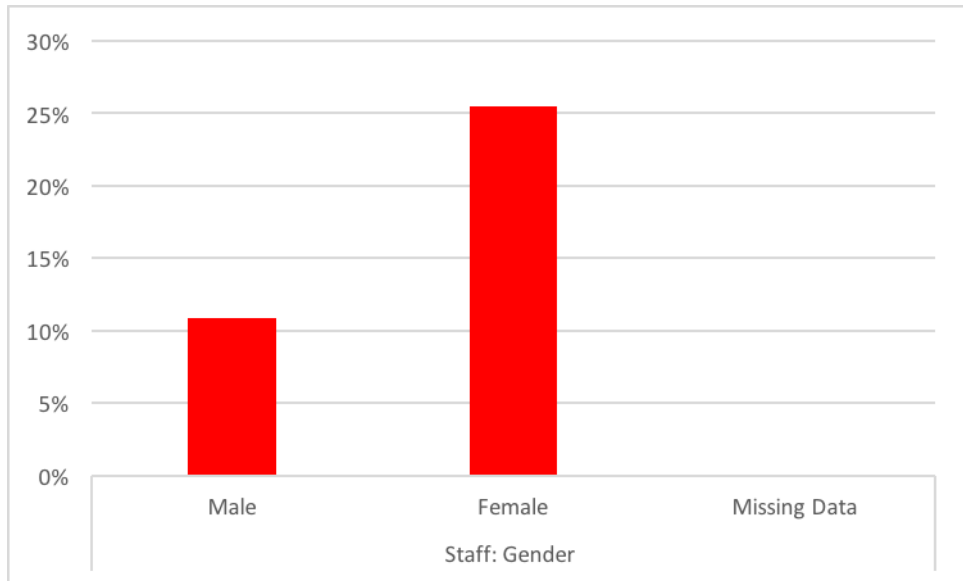
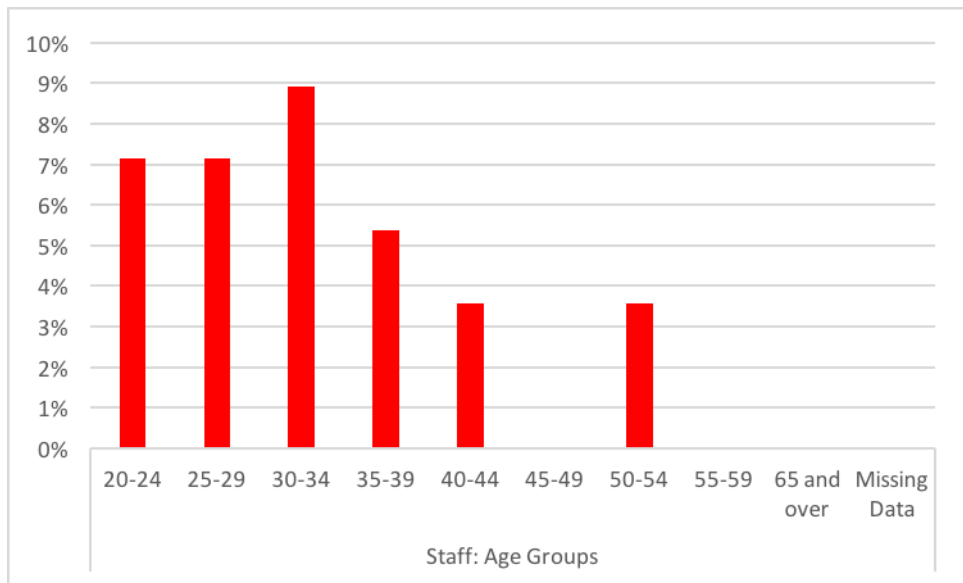
